

20 EXERCISES FOR AN EMPTY ROOM (a script for Wireframe)

1. Close your eyes. Turn off the lights. Open your eyes.
2. Turn off the lights. Wait completely still until your eyes are accustomed to the dark.
3. Turn off the lights. Clap your hands once as hard as possible.
4. Turn off the lights. Stomp your foot once as hard as possible.
5. Turn off the lights. Play a recording of the room or another room in the room.
6. Turn off the lights. Press your naked body as hard as possible against the wall or floor for at least one minute.
7. Turn off the lights. Measure the length of each wall according to the span of your arms.
8. Turn off the lights. Walk with your hand lightly grazing the wall the full circumference of the room.
9. Turn off the lights. Draw on the back of this piece of paper a floorplan of the room in as much detail as possible using one continuous line.
10. Turn off the lights. Draw on the wall.
11. Turn off the lights. Stand in the centre of the room. Taking a full minute, slowly pivot one full rotation.
12. Turn off the lights. Close your eyes. Plug your ears and spin in the centre of the room quickly for at least a minute. Stop. Unplug your ears. Open your eyes. Walk towards the wall you were originally facing.
13. Turn off the lights. Find a partner located on the opposite side of the room while neither person makes a sound.
14. Turn off the lights. Find a partner located on the opposite side of the room when it is full of people.
15. Turn off the lights. Surround the circumference of the room with people shoulder to shoulder and their backs to the walls. Everyone knock on the walls for one minute.
16. Turn off the lights. Tap on the walls to determine the structure behind the surface.
17. Turn off the lights. Puncture the wall until you see light enter the room.
18. Turn off the lights. Create a new room within the current room.
19. Turn off the lights. Wait perfectly still until someone else turns on the lights.
20. Close your eyes tight. Turn on the Lights. Open your eyes.
